This year's program will culminate in golf awards being presented Oct. 14th at the Penticton Trade & Convention Centre in conjunction with the 2010 PGA of BC Trade Show.

Awards will be presented in the following categories:

- Head Professional of the Year
- Assistant Professional of the Year
- Teacher of the Year
- Junior Promoter of the Year
- Sales Representative of the Year
- Golf Facility of the Year
- Golf Shop of the Year

Two other awards are determined by the Board of Directors:

- Player of the Year
- Patron of the Year

As in previous years, the B.C. zone will be defined by four geographic regions: Lower Mainland, Vancouver Island, Interior and Kootenays/North.

Regional Nominating Committees in each of these regions will consider nominations in the various award categories. Each committee will then select a Regional Finalist in

each category.

The names of the Finalists along with supporting information will be forwarded to a Final Selection Panel made up of previous winners of the Golf Awards. The panel will determine a winner in each category based on a weighted ballot. Winners will be announced Oct. 14th.

Nominations from PGA of BC members will be open until Friday, Sept. 3rd.
