## ***Palsenbarg equals competitive course record enroute to victory***

***Matt Palsenbarg of Northview G&CC captured the 2010 FlightScope PGA of BC Assistants' Championship presented by Cleveland Golf/Srixon Canada and Rampion Enterprises in Chilliwack earlier this week.***



Starting with three birdies in a row and shooting an incredible 30 on the back nine of his second round, Palsenbarg equalled Chilliwack Golf Club's competitive course record of eight-under 63 held by Kyle German of Point Roberts G & CC to finish the two day event at -12, five shots ahead of Bryn Parry of Seymour Creek.

Shaughnessy's Lindsay Bernakevitch was third with Shingo Akizuki of Mayfair Lakes fourth.

Palsenbarg's win was worth \$3,000 from the \$18,000 prize purse. It marks his second PGA of BC Assistants' Championship plus a Canadian Assistants' title won in Quebec in 2009.

A field of 72 Assistant Professionals faced some threatening skies and a wet golf course on Monday from persistent recent rain, but enjoyed beautiful sunshine Tuesday for their second round. A total of 30 professionals cashed cheques in the event, with one of the largest purses of the year.

Special thanks to Chilliwack General Manager Kerry Grittner and Head Professional Keith Jackson and their staff for an excellent job of hosting the event.

## ***Norm Jarvis cruises to 2010 Seniors' title***

***Former touring professional Norm Jarvis of Eaglequest Coyote Creek was the runaway winner of the 2010 ParSports and Paragon PGA of BC Seniors' Championship presented by Peregrine Plastics.***



Jarvis followed up his first-round 69 with a three-under 68 Tuesday to finish at 5-under par 137, six better than Daryl Stubbs of Cove Links. Past champion Cec Ferguson of Vernon G&CC finished third and also claimed top money in the Super Seniors Division.

For the victory, Jarvis won \$2,000 from the \$7,500 Seniors' prize purse.

A field of 19 seniors took part in the event at Chilliwack Golf Club, held concurrently with the Assistants' and Women's Championships.

Chartrand, the 2003 champion, fired a final-round 73 to finish the two-day event at 150. That was six better than three-time past champion Patty Jonas of Morgan Creek and eight in front of Samantha Curry of Eaglequest Coyote Creek. Chartrand's win was worth \$800.
