In June, throughout BC, golf pros will golf from sunrise to sunset, lending their muscles to people who have lost the use of their own to ALS.

ALS (Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis) is a fatal nerodegenerative disorder that affects a person's motor neurons that carry messages to the muscles resulting in weakness and wasting in arms, legs, mouth, throat, and elsewhere; typically the person is immobilized or deceased within two to five years of the initial diagnosis. ALS rarely effects the senses. There are 300 people living with ALS in BC at any given time.
