



## Becoming a Member of the PGA of British Columbia

In order to apply for membership with the PGA of Canada, all Applicants must meet and complete the following criteria below:

- ✓ Active Employment within the Golf Industry
- ✓ Completion of High School Education or Higher
- ✓ Be 18 Years of Age or Older

### Step 1 – Registration with the PGA of Canada

- Apply and Register with PGA of Canada → [Click Here](#)
- Declare place of employment and pay \$225+GST Application Fee
- Upload your Proof of Age to your PGA of Canada Profile (Government issued driver's licence or passport are ideal)
- Upload Proof of High School completion to your PGA of Canada Profile (transcript of your High School, College/University or Copy of diploma/certificate/degree are ideal)

### Step 2 – Registration with the PGA of British Columbia

- Pay \$500+GST PGA BC Zone Fee → [Click Here](#)

### Step 3 – Playing Ability Test

- View the 2019 PGA of British Columbia Playing Ability Test (PAT) Schedule → [Click Here](#)
- Register & Pay for your desired PAT event by contacting the event organizers directly
- Once confirmed entry with the event organizers, declare your PAT event on your PGA of Canada Profile → [Click Here](#)

### Step 4 – Complete Application Process to join PGA of Canada after passing PAT

- Complete the PGA of Canada/Sunlife Beneficiary Card

- FYI for future addition – letter of employment may hopefully be required. No need to include this for the time being but hopefully this will be confirmed.
