

Order of Merit / Tournaments Points Race

The PGA of BC's **Kal Tire Cup** has been updated to better recognize golf professionals for not only their performance but also their participation across a wider range of competitions throughout British Columbia and Canada. Key changes include:

- Points are now awarded for both results in the PGA of BC Stroke Play Championships and participation in these and other events, emphasizing the importance of active engagement in tournament golf.
- The selection of specific Regional Tour events for Order of Merit points has been removed. Points are now based on a professional's finish in their Regional Tours' overall Order of Merit standings.
- A broader range of competitions, including national championships, the RBC scramble, and other professional tournaments, will now contribute to Order of Merit points, recognizing a wider scope of professional involvement.

This revised approach aims to more fully represent a professional's engagement and performance throughout the tournament season, encouraging broader participation and competitive acknowledgement in golf across the province.

Player of the Year Awards

While the PGA of BC's Player of the Year award may often go to its Kal Tire Cup Champion, Male and Female Player of the Year recognition also encompasses tournament results outside of the PGA of BC's schedule (ie. National events, PGA-affilliated-tour events, etc.) which may also be considered.

Professional Development Program (PDP) Points Race

The PGA of BC's **Sunice & Bobby Jones Medal** is presented to the association's annual leading points getter from its **Professional Development Program.** Initiated in 2013, the PDP has been a cornerstone in acknowledging members who prioritize professional growth and contributions within the golf industry. Originally, the PDP was an annual points race designed to honor members for their extensive involvement and achievements across several domains—education, participation in tournaments and other events, contributions to the industry, and personal development. This approach aimed at identifying and celebrating the association's members who prioritize career and professional development, recognized at key Association events like the Annual General Meeting and Spring Education Seminar.

Starting in 2024, the PDP has undergone significant changes, with a new, narrowed focus primarily on education as well as golf-industry volunteerism. These modifications to the PDP signify an evolved perspective on professional development within the PGA of BC, stressing the importance of education and involvement in the PGA of BC as a key component of industry leadership and excellence.

Professional Development Award

While the PGA of BC's Davie Black Professional Development Award may often go to its Sunice & Bobby Jones Medalist, the PDP recognition also encompasses education and development efforts outside of the PGA of BC's schedule which may also be considered.

Community Engagement Program (CEP) Points Race

Launching in 2024, the PGA of BC's Community

Engagement Program aims to recognize golf professionals across British Columbia who prioritize community involvement, public volunteerism, and other charitable efforts. This initiative rewards active involvement in key community events like the ALS Golfathon, Junior Golf Week, and Women's Golf Week, with points awarded for promoting, participating in, and fundraising for these and other community initiatives.

The program also values broader community involvement, such as volunteer work, engagement in other sports, and various fundraising activities, recognizing the diverse contributions of golf professionals beyond the course.

Crucially, the program places a strong emphasis on the use of social media as a powerful tool for professionals to positively promote the PGA of BC, including educational events and tournaments. This strategy aims to increase the association's visibility and accessibility, making it more public-facing and enhancing reputation and brand growth.


